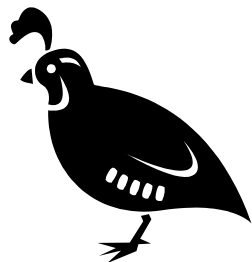

Do you farm ground . . .

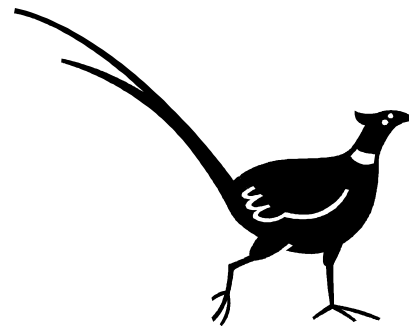
- that is marginal in yield no matter what you do?
